Sara Koplik, Ph.D. is the author of A Political and Economic History of the Jews of Afghanistan. She edited the New Mexico Jewish Link for a decade, and has been director of the Aaron David Bram Hillel House at the University of New Mexico since 2010. Born in Albuquerque and raised within its Jewish community, she received a master's degree in Central Asian studies and a doctorate in Middle Eastern history from the School of Oriental and African Studies at the University of London.

Sara founded the Sephardic heritage program at the Jewish Federation of New Mexico, and from 2016-2021 helped thousands of individuals across the world certify their ancestral Sephardic roots. She also served as president of the North Campus Neighborhood Association for over a decade, and led the effort to preserve the largest green space in the urban core of Albuquerque.
